Is ordered to _____-Year(s) of Interim Probation Supervision to include the following terms and conditions:

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Report to a Probation Officer as directed by the Court or the Probation Officer and permit the Probation Officer to visit you at your place of abode or elsewhere.
2. Remain within the jurisdiction of the Court unless granted permission to leave by the Court or Probation.
3. Honestly answer all reasonable inquiries by the Probation Officer and notify the Probation Officer prior to any change in address or employment.
4. Work faithfully at suitable employment or pursue a course of study that will equip you for employment.
5. Observe and obey all Court Orders, the laws of the State of New York, the laws of the United States of America, and the laws and ordinances of any municipal division thereof.
6. You must report **ANY INVOLVEMENT** with **ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY or OFFICER** to your Supervising Probation Officer within 24 hours.
7. Submit to searches of your person, vehicle, and/or property, at any time, with or without notice, by any authorized Probation Officer and his or her agent(s) for the purpose of monitoring Probation Conditions.
8. Satisfy any other conditions reasonably related to your Probation Supervision or rehabilitation.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 9. Support your dependents and meet other family responsibilities.
- 10. Cannot possess, purchase, or consume any liquid or substance which contains Ethyl Alcohol.
- 11. Cannot enter establishments that sell alcohol over a bar, except for restaurants and bowling alleys for the purpose of dining and bowling.
- 12. Cannot possess, purchase, or consume illicit drugs or mind altering substances without a valid prescription. Prescriptions must be followed as written.
- 13. Submit to periodic tests to determine the use of alcohol, drugs, or mind altering substances upon the request of the Court or Probation Officer; and pay for any tests which demonstrate a positive result.
- 14. Participate in and cooperate with an evaluation, counseling, and/or treatment program including:
 - A. Inpatient and/or Outpatient Medical, Psychological, and Mental Health as recommended.
 - B. Inpatient and/or Outpatient Alcohol and or Substance Abuse as recommended.
 - C. Inpatient and/or Outpatient Anger Management and/or Domestic Violence as recommended.
 - D. Aftercare programs including Halfway or Supportive Housing as recommended.
- 15. Sign any requested release(s) for information for the Probation Department.
- 16. Cannot record any audio, video, or photographic media of any conversation(s) or interaction(s) with Probation Officers or Probation Department Staff.
- 17. Provide the Probation Department with your user ID and password information for all social media, computer logins, and remote storage accounts.
- 18. Cannot purchase, use, sell, possess, or manufacture any of the following items/weapons, without the prior written permission of your Supervising Probation Officer and the Director of Probation:
 - A. Deadly weapon(s) and/or dangerous instrument(s) as defined by NYS PL §10.00(12) and §10.00(13)
 - B. Any items/weapons as identified or specified in NYS PL §265 or the parts thereof.
 - C. Bow(s), crossbow(s), arrow(s) and/or the parts thereof.
 - D. Noxious substances, as defined by NYS PL §270.05, including Oleoresin Capsicum (Pepper Spray).
 - E. Any other items determined to be a weapon or a dangerous instrument by the Probation Department.

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- 19. Submit to Electronic Monitoring if directed by court order or as a graduated sanction by your Probation Officer in lieu of a violation. Pay associated fees of said device unless granted a waiver.
- 20. Cannot associate with persons as specified by the Court or the Probation Department, to include the below named individuals, and any other individuals as named by Probation:

- 21. Cannot enter residences, establishments, or be at locations as specified by the Court or the Probation Department, to include the below listed locations, and any other locations as named by Probation:

- 22. RESTITUTION: See attached Court Order for restitution with appropriate surcharge.
- 23. Perform _____ hours of community service under the direction of the Community Service Coordinator to be completed within 12 months.
- 24. Provide a DNA sample for testing as mandated by Executive Law 995-C for designated offenders.
- 25. Provide a DNA sample for testing for the Subject Index as authorized by Executive Law 49-B.
- 26. If I leave New York State without permission, I freely and voluntarily agree to waive any right to extradition. I will not resist extradition for my return to NY and I agree to pay any associated costs.
- 27. Driver's License to be applied for and used only after approval from the Court and Supervising Probation Officer; cannot operate any motorized vehicle on a public highway without a valid license.
- 28. Attend one session of a victim impact panel and provide proof of attendance/completion to Probation.
- 29. If deemed eligible for participation in a Drug Treatment Court Program, and if directed to attend by your Supervising Probation Officer, you must participate in and successfully complete said program.
- 30. Cannot communicate with, physically contact, assault, stalk, follow, harass, annoy, terrorize, or threaten, the victim, their family, friends, or colleagues, either in person or remotely, or cause the above conduct to occur through the use of a third party.
 - A. The probationer may apply for permission to contact the victim, for reasonable and lawful purposes only, through the Court and/or the Probation Department
 - B. Prior written permission must be granted before the probationer would be allowed to contact the victim.
- 31. Must disclose any and all new intimate relationships and/or partners, along with contact information, to your Supervising Probation Officer.
- 32. Must attend, participate in, cooperate with, and successfully complete a 26 or 52 week Domestic Violence Intervention Program, as approved by the Probation Department and pay all associated fees.
- 33. Submit to and pay for any polygraph examinations as requested and/or required by your Domestic Violence Intervention Program and/or the Probation Department.
- 34. Must participate in and cooperate with: Child and/or Adult Protective Services, Department of Social Services and Family Court as requested or required by said agencies and/or the Probation Department.
 - A. Must provide your Supervising Probation Officer with copies of all court documentation, correspondence, orders, and/or investigative materials. You must inform your Supervising Probation Officer of all court dates, meetings, interactions, and/or appointments pertaining to the above listed agencies
