**OBJECTIVE: TO DEFINE AND LIST THE PATROL AREAS FOR MEMBERS ASSIGNED TO THE PATROL DIVISION OF THE SCHUYLER COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE.**

**POLICY: It is the policy of the Schuyler County Sheriff's Office to follow the guidelines set forth in this order.**

**DETAILS:**

**I. Patrol Areas- Generally**

- A. Patrol areas of the Schuyler County Sheriff's Office shall be at all times contingent upon the actual number of uniformed officers who are working at any given time.
- B. No one person is able to foresee which particular patrol area might have the heaviest complaint load. For this reason, the on duty patrol supervisor or dispatch shall have the ultimate authority for changing patrol areas, or assigning one or more patrols to a given area, based upon current activity.

**II. Patrol Areas-Specifically**

- A. As Schuyler County is not a large county patrol area or sectors are hard to establish. In regards to patrol areas the county shall be divided in half, with Seneca Lake being the middle, and the patrol areas being established as East and West.
  - 1. The East side patrol area shall encompass the Towns of Hector, Catherine, Cayuta and Montour.
  - 2. The West side patrol area shall encompass the Towns of Dix, Orange, Tyrone and Reading.
  - 3. If a third patrol is on duty then their patrol area shall be the entire County and be dispatched as needed to answer complaints.

4. If a fourth patrol is on then the patrols shall be divided equally to both East and West sides of the County.
5. The Village of Montour Falls shall be considered part of both East and West patrol areas and the closest patrol shall be dispatched to handle complaints.
