RE: AUTHORIZE ADVERTISEMENT TO RECEIVE SEALED BIDS FOR COURTHOUSE
RENOVATIONS – BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the New York State Unified Court System recommends that the county renovate the main courtroom and certain related areas of the courthouse complex, and

WHEREAS, the Buildings and Grounds Department has identified certain other items of renovation and repair within the courthouse complex, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 103 of General Municipal Law, all contracts for public work involving an expenditure of more than thirty-five thousand dollars and all purchase contracts involving an expenditure of more than twenty thousand dollars shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder after advertising for sealed bids in the manner provided by law, and

WHEREAS, Engineering Services related to the project have been contracted for with Hunt Engineers, Architects, Land Surveyors & Landscape Architect DPC, and include preparation of specifications for bidding pursuant to the General Municipal Law, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Buildings & Grounds Department under the leadership of the Highway Superintendent be authorized to advertise to receive sealed bids for the above renovations, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk of the Legislature will receive bids to be opened publicly with an award made at a future Meeting of the Legislature, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County of Schuyler reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids, and to readvertise if desired.
